

The programme has been very successful in introducing young children to football and encouraging them to get involved in physical activity from an early age.

It is structured around a series of fun games and activities, which are designed to develop the children's coordination, balance, and motor skills. The Tiger Cubs Programme is delivered by highly qualified QPR coaches and aims to promote social, physical, and mental well-being. The Tiger Cubs play in the Middlesex Pan Disability League and enter the DS Active National Cup and other tournaments. The emphasis is on building confidence and having fun, rather than on winning or competition.

**QPR FC Women (previously QPR Ladies)** have a strong footballing history, stretching back over 50 years to the teams inception in 1969. A highlight arguably was winning the FA Cup in 1976/77 beating Southampton 1-0 and appearing in the final again the following year...if sadly this time on the wrong side of a resurgent Southampton team.

In more recent times, at the start of the 2019/20 season QPR in the Community Trust took over the running of the Womens set up with the Girls teams following in 2022/23. This has allowed greater access to club resources and support from various internal departments across QPR. We have girls teams from Under 10 through to Under 16, a Development squad and a Senior team.

It is our intention to progress as many players as possible from our junior into senior squads and this has been further strengthened with the Trust's Female College Academy allowing Development squad players more time on the pitch. In the Senior teams second season with the Trust and despite the interruptions to football caused by the pandemic we brought home silverware in the form of the Senior Capital Cup and gained promotion to Tier 4 of the football pyramid - the FA Womens National

League.

It was our first season in the FA WNL that NNR Global Logistics became front of shirt partner for the Womens team and after two successful seasons we are thrilled they have agreed to a further 2 year extension to see us into 2025.

Lee and Gary in particular have been incredibly supportive and visibly invested in the team, making it to as many games as they can. This is warmly felt by the players and staff at the club and we look forward to the next two seasons further cementing that partnership.

Some of our senior and development team players are taking part in todays match. thankyou to Lee for the invite and we look forward to a final run out of the season at Loftus Road wearing the Blue & White Hoops!


